PROGRAMS

- Front Office** (ongoing) – Assist Office Manager by answering phones, welcoming and guiding visitors around the Heritage Center, registering education participants and staffing the gift shop

- Oyster Festival** (September) – Host DRA information table

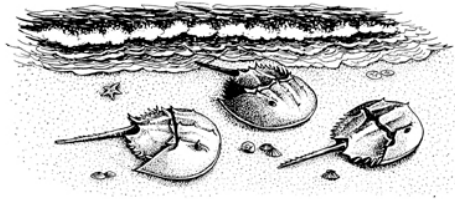
